## PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT CAN'T TAKE CARE OF YOU IF YOU HAVEN'T TAKEN CARE OF IT!

When it comes to Personal Protection Equipment (PPE), safety precautions begin before you put anything on. You first need to identify and assess the hazard – typically done through a Pre-Job Hazard Assessment (PJHA). If and only when during the risk assessment process in determining the risk control measures of a particular hazard, do you then select the appropriate PPE for the task.

Always remember to maintain your PPE so it is safe to use at any time and inspect each piece of the equipment before you put it on. Never assume it is ready to be used – being sure is the best way to be safe!
