## CHEMISTRY AND CARELESSNESS DON'T MIX

Improperly storing, handling, or mixing chemicals can pose serious safety and environmental risks. Before working with any chemicals, ensure that the proper controls are in place, personal protective equipment is used, and that all involved are aware of the nearest eye wash stations or safety showers as appropriate.

Everyone is required to review the appropriate safety data sheets and fully understand the potential hazards.

If work with chemicals is required to be undertaken in a confined space, allow only trained and certified workers to perform the tasks.

If a hazardous chemical is spilled, take the necessary emergency response action as indicated in the emergency response plan. Some spills may require additional external reporting and should be done so in accordance with the local laws and regulations.
