






Did You Know...

How to Select the Right Fire Extinguisher for the Job



Type	What's Burning	Contents of Extinguisher
	Wood, paper, rags, rubber, etc.	Water – type, foam, halon, multi-purpose dry chemical
	Flammable liquids, gases, grease	Carbon dioxide, dry chemical, foam, multi-purpose dry chemical, water fog, halon
	Live electrical current	Multi-purpose dry chemical, dry chemical, carbon dioxide, halon
	Burning metals	Special dry chemical (i.e. sodium chloride base)
	Vegetable or animal oils	Potassium Acetate Solution, will foam to create a barrier between oil and O2

Pull

Pull the pin (or other motion) to unlock the extinguisher.



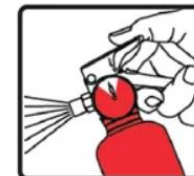
Aim

Aim at the base (bottom) of the fire and stand 6 - 10 feet away.



Squeeze

Squeeze the lever to discharge the agent.



Sweep

Sweep the spray from left to right until the flames are totally extinguished.
