WINTER DRIVING TIPS: FLOOR MATS

Due to slushy winter conditions, you might consider switching out your usual floor mats for thicker material or rubber ones. Improperly installed floor mats in your vehicle could interfere with the operation of the accelerator or brake pedal, increasing the risk of an accident.

Follow the manufacturer's instructions for mat installation and use retention clips to secure the mats.
